Beginning & ending of Ramadan are subject to sighting of the Moon the Month of Blessing, Mercy & forgiveness

FASTING IN THE MONTH OF RAMADAN IS COMPULSORY ON EVERY MUSLIM ADULT. IF YOU BREAK YOUR FAST INTENTIONALLY WITHOUT AN EXCUSE, THEN IT IS COMPULSORY FOR YOU TO DO SIXTY CONSECUTIVE FAST. NEVERTHELESS, THESE SIXTY FAST WILL NOT BE EQUAL TO THE ONE FAST OF RAMADAN MONTH. FASTING IS INTENDED TO TEACH MUSLIMS ABOUT PATIENCE, HUMANITY AND SPIRITUALITY. EVERYONE SHOULD ENDEAVOUR TO PRAY THE TARAWIH PRAYERS. THIS IS PRACTICE THAT SHOULD NOT BE LEFT WITHOUT AN EXCUSE. THE HOLY QURAN WAS REVEALED IN THIS MONTH. SO TRY TO RECITE THE QURAN AS MUCH AS YOU CAN. RAMADAN IS AMONG OTHER THINGS, A CELEBRATION OF THE QORAN. SADAQT-UL-FITR IS ARE OBLIGATION FOR EVERY MUSLIM, MALE OR FEMALE, WHO OWNS 613.35 GRAMS OF SILVER OR ITS EQUIVALENT. IT IS A SUNNAH THAT THE SADAQT-UL-FITR IS PAID BEFORE PERFORMING THE EID-PRAYER
